Girl Scouts of Kentucky's Wilderness Road Council (GSKWRC) would like to extend an invitation to all girls and boys attending 6th grade in the fall at Campbell County Middle School.

Come join us for a day of fun and creativity as each girl/boy may have the opportunity to participate in each of the following activities:

School Orientation/Teacher Talk – students will have the opportunity to meet fellow classmates, get familiar with the daily routine of changing classes, and discover other useful tips about the school.

School Survival – Can you survive the maze of middle school? Participate in the game of survival as students orienteer their way through the halls in a quest to be the first team to complete all of their challenges.

Study Skills – Students will discover their individual learning styles and be taught skills in time management, organization and note taking. Students will also be educated in test taking and reading strategies.

Team Building – Test your problem solving skills as you work together with fellow students to conquer the challenges set before you.
