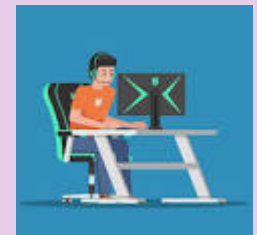

## HEALTH SERVICES

Dear Parent/Guardian

As your student prepares for sixth grade, please note that they will need the following **required** health records completed & **turned in prior to starting the new school year.**

1. **An updated physical recorded on the Kentucky Preventative Health Care Examination Form**
  - The Preventative Healthcare Exam can be completed within one year prior to sixth-grade entry.
  - Please note that KHSAA Athletic Participation/Physical form **does not** take the place of this required physical examination.
2. **An updated Kentucky Immunization Certificate showing all age-appropriate vaccines.**
  - The Immunization Certificate should include all of the following immunizations:
    - **Five (5) DTP or DtaP**
    - **Four (4) OPV or IPV**
    - **Three (3) doses of Hep B – the first two doses must be separated by at least 4 weeks; the third dose must be at least 8 weeks after the second dose and at least 4 months after the first dose.**
    - **Two (2) doses of MMR**
    - **Two (2) doses of Hep A –\*This is a new requirement starting this school year\* Six months between first and second dose.**
    - **Two (2) doses of Varicella or a history of chickenpox (must be recorded on Immunization Certificate)**
    - **One (1) dose of Tdap. This is required for students at 6<sup>th</sup> grade entry, 11 or 12 years or older**
    - **One (1) dose of Meningococcal Vaccine for 6<sup>th</sup> grade entry, 11 or 12 years or older.**

Immunizations are available at the Campbell County Health Center for all children for a minimal fee. Families without health insurance qualify for the Vaccines for Children program which provides immunizations to children free of charge through the Health Department and through many private health care providers.

Please call now to make an appointment to have these health requirements completed **prior** the start of the upcoming new school year.
