## 2020-2021 - Campbell County Preschool Program Information COVID19 UPDATE

The mission of the Campbell County Preschool is to engage children and families in high quality social and educational activities in order to introduce children to a caring and nurturing learning environment to promote success in school and in later life.

<b>Parts of Preschool Day &amp; Transition Process</b>	<b>Descriptions</b>
<b><u>SCHEDULE</u></b>	<p>During the period of COVID19, preschool classes will be conducted on a hybrid schedule. Students will attend either Group A (Monday/Tuesday) or Group B (Thursday/Friday). Each group will attend either in the morning or the afternoon. Each session will be limited to 10 students to promote social distancing. Students will be grouped in order to be able to attend during the same time as siblings on a hybrid schedule in other grades.</p> <p><b>There is no virtual option for preschool unless schools are closed. SEE BELOW.</b></p>

<b><u>Meal/Snack</u></b>	AM – Breakfast <b><u>OR</u></b> PM – Lunch
<b><u>Transportation</u></b>	AM/PM – Home to School and School to Home

<b><u>Important Dates</u></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Home Visits – These may be conducted virtually during the period of COVID19.</li> <li>• <b>Preschool Start Date – September 21, 2020</b></li> <li>• <b>Preschool services will begin virtually on Sept. 21 and continue until schools are open. When schools open, the Hybrid-only schedule above will commence.</b></li> <li>• <b>Preschool End Date – June 4, 2021</b></li> </ul> <p><u>ALL SCREENINGS for 2020-2021 will be conducted virtually.</u> Call 859-635-2173 and ask for preschool screening information or you may check the website.</p>
<b><u>Preschool Students attending a Private School</u></b>	Preschool students who are placed by their parents in a private school do not qualify for service plans. If a student meets eligibility criteria for speech services, that student must be enrolled in the public school by their parent in order to receive services under an IEP. Services shall be offered within the school day for 30 minutes per week.
<b><u>“Universal” Fours</u></b>	Students who are four by August 1 of the current school year, but do not meet the requirements for disability or at-risk may attend preschool at no cost on a <b><u>space available only</u></b> basis. These students may be transported to the program by the school district.
