

Hello,

During Non-Traditional Instructional Days, your fourth-grade child will be instructed to complete school work for 2 hours per school day. 40 minutes of that time will be for science. I will provide you detailed instructions for daily assignments. In order to ensure that all of our students are still participating in instructional activities that will help them retain information already taught in fourth grade, we will need evidence of the completed paper/pencil activities. This will be a teamwork effort to make sure student needs are met while not engaging in learning at school.

Science activities may include:

- Reading pages from the science textbooks. Your child should have a book with either a fish or panda on the cover. I had to do it this way because I didn't have a complete set for everyone to use.
- Responding to what was read by writing a reflection.
- Responding by answering questions.
- Drawing diagrams to demonstrate understanding.

Tracking Progress

We are asking that you take a picture of your child's completed assignment and submit it as a message through Class Dojo. Compass and IXL activities can be checked on my end, so you will not need to send me information regarding technology time. If you do not have access to technology, you will have a different activity to complete to replace technology time. I will be keeping track of completed work through a spreadsheet in my Google drive.
