Opening Business

Call to Order Mr. Moore at 5:30 PM

Approval of Agenda Move to approve agenda as presented by Mr. Hitch Seconded by Ms. Huff Motion carried by Consensus of the Council

Good News Report: Mr. Moore shared that Girls Cross Country Team was 3rd in the state-highest ever finish by the team; about 50 CCMS students participated in the Youth Leadership Summit at NKU; successful implementation of PBIS Team Rewards; PTO Fall Craft Fair-packed last weekend; Fall Sports conclusion – football teams did really well; volleyball had a great season also. Awards banquet is Nov. 14.

No public comments – no guests.

Policy Reviews:

Writing Policy #23 –Have the ELA department review and see where we are at this point. The policy needs to be cleaned up. Would like to have a 1st reading of a writing policy in November if small revisions; however, if large overhaul, may need to go to a committee at that time.

Technology Use Policy #21- CCMS limited on lab space and really needs to be one to one; however, we don't have the capability at this time.

Communications:

Budget Report-\$68,619.05 remaining for the rest of the school year. We should get an adjustment to our budget because of our enrollment.

FRC Report – 70 students receive backpack meals currently. Care Closet donated \$325.00 worth of clothing. Planned the Youth Summit. Provided furniture and clothing for students. Walmart has been an amazing partner for High Attendance Month and school supplies. PTO helped with choir outfits for concerts. She has begun Christmas assistance.

Committee Reports:

PBIS Committee- Behavior Flowchart – Camels Against Bullying Week – Student of the Week – Readdressing more problematic behaviors

Scheduling Committee – Had 9 original schedules and narrowed it down to 2. Will go on 2 site visits to make a determination of which schedules would work best for CCMS.

KPREP Results: CCMS is a TSI school because of our students with disability. Mr. Moore shared some comparison data with the committee.

MAP Results – shows where students are in preparation for KPREP at this time for reading and math; Novice reduction has to be a huge part of our focus. Mr. Moore also shared the student growth summary report. The sixth grade scored significantly below their projected growth; 7th grade above; and 8th grade at just about their projected growth at least on math.

School Report Card – Data entry about the school based upon last year; Committee Members signed off on the document. Mr. Huber moved to approve the school report card. Mr. Marks seconded the motion. The motion carried by Consensus of the Council.

School Improvement Plan – Action Plan- Mr. Moore shared that there are 4 goals: 1. Behavior data; 2) Increase in mean %ile Spring data from 2018 to 2019. 51% outscoring their projected growth; 3) 50% of staff reporting that staff professional learning needs are met; 4) SpEd students will obtain a targeted score of 10.1.
